

Washington, DC -- U.S. Rep. Michael A. Arcuri (NY-24) concluded an aggressive and expansive work schedule over the last two weeks that allowed him to meet face-to-face with constituents in all 11 counties of the 24th Congressional District during Congress' annual April District Work Period.
