Arcuri will be accompanied by representatives from the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) and the AARP to answer questions from seniors.

In February, President Bush signed the Recovery Rebates and Economic Stimulus for the American People Act into law, providing 8.3 million New York families with tax rebates of up to \$1,200 per couple, plus \$300 per child as early as mid-May. Seniors and veterans with qualified income of least \$3,000 in 2007 would get at least \$300 per individual and \$600 per couple, plus the same child tax credit of \$300.
