

Washington, DC -- U.S. Representative Michael A. Arcuri (D-Utica) will host an alternative energy roundtable in Tompkins County on Saturday, February 17, 2007.

In January, The U.S. House of Representatives passed the CLEAN Energy Act (H.R. 6), which would repeal \$14 billion in subsidies given to big oil and gas companies over 10 years and invest those funds in clean, renewable energy research and development.

As a cosponsor of H.R. 6, Arcuri will use this roundtable discussion with experts and community members to collect local ideas on alternative energy programs that would benefit Upstate New York both economically and environmentally.
